

INDIANA JONES

PURPOSE: A fun drill to work on stickhandling, passing skills and breakaways for younger players.

SET-UP: Divide players into two teams and line each team up along the boards between the blue lines on opposite sides of the ice. The last player in the X line carries his puck down around the cone and up the center of the ice. All players in the O line have a puck and try to pass

it to knock the puck off the X player's sticks in the neutral zone. If they are successful, the X player returns to the end of the X line. If he successfully maneuvers his puck through the neutral zone, he continues down the ice to try to score on the goalie and then returns to the end of the line. A player from the O team then has an opportunity to be Indiana Jones to the other end. Each player gets one or two opportunities and the team with the most goals at the end wins.
